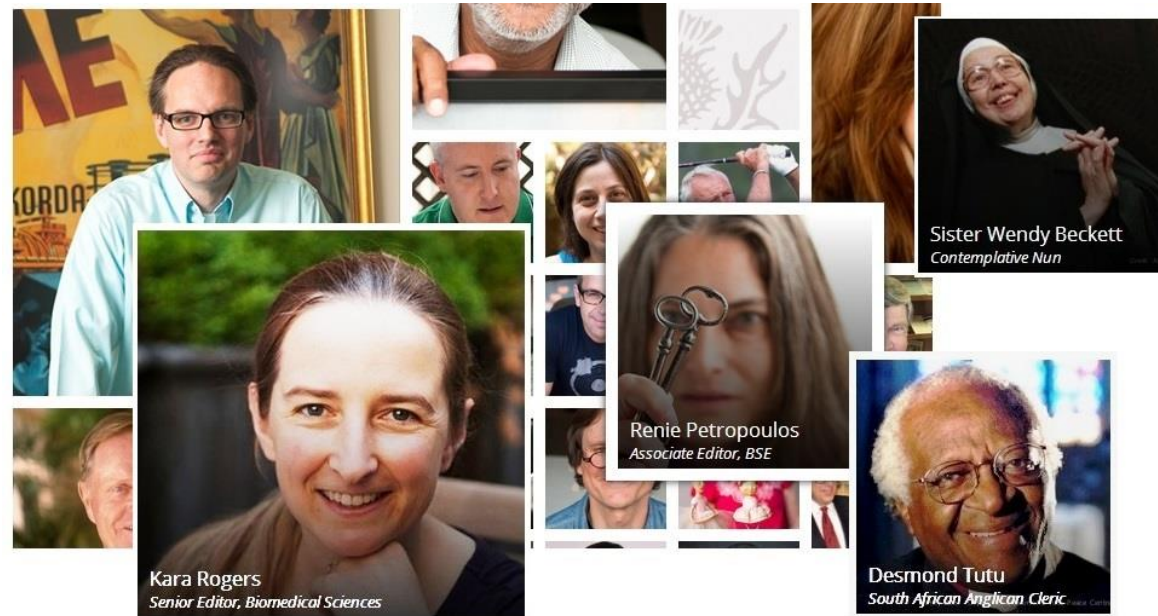



Getting to the Core of Climate Change

What image may come to mind when the word glacier is heard? Before answering that question, here is another one: glaciers are part of the Earth's "cryosphere"—so what is the cryosphere? The cryosphere includes any place on our planet's surface covered with water in the form of snow, ice on land or sea, and permafrost. As such, the cryosphere is part of the hydrosphere and could be thought of as the "frozen water" part of the Earth. The cryosphere plays a significant role in our planet's climate, and an understanding of how climate has changed in the past may provide information about what to expect in the future. Scientists that study the climate history of the cryosphere (paleoclimatology) study global ice in a variety of ways, including data and observations from Earth's orbit, flyovers with instrument-equipped airplanes, and a ground-based collection of observations and data (see Hunting for Ice on Hudson Bay in Resources).

NASA's Operation IceBridge is an airborne flyover of the ice at both the North and South Pole. A variety of instrument-documented changes in the gain or loss in the thickness and mass of ice on land and sea as well as glaciers. Data collected by IceBridge is added to data from previous and current NASA satellite missions, ICESat, ICESat-2, and the ESA's satellite missions Cryo-Sat and CryoSat-2 (see Resources). All the airborne and satellite missions make some of the measurements using either radar or laser altimetry. As a side note, this is the technology that allowed us to map the surface of Venus, for example (see


